

Hmong Bua in Laos



After several generations of separation from their homeland, the Hmong Bua people in Laos have developed their own identity. Today most of the various Hmong subgroups do not acknowledge kinship with one another even if they speak the same language. The majority of Hmong Bua are animists.

Obstacles

They are only unreached in Laos, a country where the gospel has made few inroads into the various ethnic groups.

Outreach Ideas

Believers in Southeast Asia who are trained in telling gospel stories and producing audio and visual Bible resources may be led by the Holy Spirit to go to the Hmong Bua people in Laos. This effort could produce new disciples and fellowships.

Prayer Focus

Pray for the Holy Spirit to give the Hmong Bua people in Laos teachable and understanding hearts. Pray that a powerful movement of the Holy Spirit would bring entire Hmong Bua families into a rich experience of
