

Kuong in Vietnam



The majority of Vietnamese people tend to look down on the indigenous groups, and the indigenous people near the Chinese border look down on the Kuong. Until recently, the Kuong were seen by many as almost animal-like hunter-gatherers. They are among the poorest tribal groups in Asia. Most Kuong live in south China, but a small group lives in northwestern Vietnam. The majority of them consider themselves Buddhists.

No written Scripture or gospel recordings exist in the Kuong language.
