Mishaba Laluo in China



The Mishaba Laluo live in Yunnan, China's most ethnically diverse province. Like most ethnic groups in this region, they are a rural people.

Ministry Obstacles

The Laluo celebrate the Festival of the Tree King, where the entire community gathers around a large tree that stands outside the village. They sacrifice a black piglet and the pig's front teeth are offered to the spirit of the tree. The rest of the pig is cooked and eaten by the people, who sing a song in praise of the power of the tree god. Such traditions keep them together as a people and accepting outside spiritual beliefs is seen as a betrayal of their people.

Outreach Ideas

There are a small number of Mishaba Laluo believers who can take Christ to their people by using the art forms they embrace as their own.

Prayer Focus

Pray for Mishaba Laluo believers to be filled with the fruit and the power of the Holy Spirit, so they can be
