he Khamnigan Ewenki are one of the four major sections of the Ewenki peoples who live in eastern Mongolia and western China. The traditional occupation of the Ewenki is nomadic animal herding. Some Ewenki have moved to Mongolian cities in hope of a better life.

Ministry Obstacles

Nomadic people are particularly difficult to reach with the gospel. The Ewenki may see Christianity in a negative light due to their experience of Russian imperialism in past generations.

Outreach Ideas

Christian medical teams can bring modern medicine and the gospel to the Ewenki.

Prayer Focus

Pray that the few Ewenki followers of Christ would grow strong in the faith. Pray for the Lord to raise up faithful pastors and Bible teachers for the Ewenki church.
