Boyu Tibetan in China



Festival of the Boyu Tibetans takes place annually on the fifth day of the fifth month of the lunar calendar. They believe if they drink the spring water on the mountain before the sun touches it, they will be free from disease, and if they bathe in the water, all evil will be kept from them. During the Flower-Gathering Festival, the Boyu worship Lianzhi, the goddess of flowers.

Ministry Obstacles

They rely on demons, ghosts, and the spirits of disembodied deities to guide their decisions. Many Buddhist monks are able to call up fearsome demons.

Outreach Ideas

Perhaps their fear of the spirit world will draw them to the only one who can save them from it. Pray for power encounters and dreams and visions of Jesus.

Pray for the Church

There are only a handful of known Christians among the Boyu Tibetans today. Pray they will take Christ to their families and communities.
