

Tujia in China



Tujia or "The People," are an unreached people group; but they consider themselves, "the aboriginal people." Yet this "original people," has significantly assimilated into the surrounding peoples since the 16th century, so that today only a few actually speak Tujia. They believe in an original "First Couple," Fuxi and Nuna, whose spirits they invoke in exorcism.

Ministry Obstacles

The biggest obstacle is their lack of faith in the God who gave them life. Instead, their faith is in other spirit beings. They consider it unacceptable for their people to embrace a God outside their traditions.

Outreach Ideas

It will be necessary to reach them via Mandarin or a nearby tribal language. Materials need to be presented as songs and skits in such a way that they do not appear foreign. Music has a way of etching itself into one's soul.

Prayer Focus

Pray that a strong community of believers would be established
