Gorani in Albania



The Gorani are a folk Islamic people who live in small villages in the rugged mountainous regions of what is now Albania, Kosovo and Macedonia. They were converted to Islam when they were conquered by the Ottomans in 1388. Geographically Gorani are claimed to be nationalized by the country they live in; however, they maintain that they are independent and Muslim. Herding and agriculture are their main form of livelihood. Their hard life, war and determination to maintain their folk Islamic identity has caused many, especially the young, to migrate to other countries.

Ministry Obstacles

Gorani's have experienced discrimination and have a strong folk Islamic identity and are not receptive to followers of Christ. Their geographic location contributes to making it hard to reach them.

Outreach Ideas

They need faithful followers of Christ to develop friendships with them so they will trust God's servants to show them the way to unknown blessings in Christ. They also need to access the JESUS Film and other gospel resources.
