



Aji in Indonesia

The Aji of South Sumatra live in 14 villages. They make a living by growing two crops: coffee and rubber. They also raise small livestock as a source of income. The Aji are Muslims and a mosque can be found in each of their villages.

Ministry Obstacles

The Aji are majority Muslim, yet they also practice worship of various objects such as war relics. These practices distance the Aji from the Lord and may cause their hearts to be hardened against the gospel.

Outreach Ideas

Linguistically, Aji is most similar to Malay. Therefore, the Malay translation of the JESUS Film may be a great tool to share the gospel.

Prayer Focus

There are a few Aji believers. Pray that they would cling to Christ and have courage to disciple others around them. Pray the Aji would soon learn to walk in the power of God's Spirit and experience love, joy, peace and all the fruit of the Spirit. Pray that there would be a movement to Christ among the Aji,
