



Kui in Cambodia

One folk tale among the Kui is that their village elders originally wrote their language on a pig skin but then dogs ate it, so their writing was lost. The Kui are mostly subsistence wet rice farmers. Farming is labor intensive, plowing with cows or water buffalo and transporting goods by oxcart. Many also gather forest products like resin, wood and traditional medicines, although this is changing due to rapid deforestation. Frequently, their diet consists of rice eaten with salt and chili peppers.

Ministry Obstacles:

In general, their previous spirit worship is less of a hindrance to the gospel than any major religious system. Buddhism is becoming more powerful in the Kui homeland.

Outreach Ideas:

The Kui have little access to good health care. They could greatly benefit from health and hygiene education, better access to clean water and improved agricultural methods. Christ followers can provide these, opening doors to the gospel.
