

Kami in Tanzania



The traditional occupation of the Kami people in Tanzania is agriculture and animal husbandry. In recent years the Kami have taken up commercial fish farming and raising poultry.

Ministry Obstacles

The mountainous area where the Kami live is hard to reach. Also, Islam is considered part of the Kami's personal identity. The Bible has not been translated into the Kami language.

Outreach Ideas

Medical teams of believers can bring the gospel to the Kami. East African followers of Christ can build friendships with the Kami, paving the way to a gospel witness.

Prayer Focus

A tiny fraction of the Kami claims to be Christians. Pray that they would be established in the faith and would grow strong in the knowledge of God. Pray for the Lord to send out loving workers to the Kami people of Tanzania. Pray that the Kami people would have a spiritual hunger that
