

# Walang in Bhutan



**W**alang people have been traders in past times. When modern roads and transportation killed trade through the Walang area, many people were left in turmoil because they had completely relied on trade as their source of income. There were few crops planted in the Walang villages and few kept animals. They are still struggling with an economic transition.

## Obstacles

Walang people adhere to Buddhism. The Walang are a desperately needy unreached people group. They have no Scripture, JESUS Film or gospel recordings in their language. Few have ever been exposed to the gospel in a meaningful way that would allow them to intelligently accept or reject Christ. It is extremely difficult for outsiders to get to rural Bhutan.

## Outreach Ideas

Passionate and consistent prayer is most likely the only possible outreach at this time.
