

Afghans in Austria



Ever since the USSR invaded Afghanistan in 1979 there have been waves of Afghan refugees fleeing for safety. Most of them have settled in either neighboring Pakistan or Iran, but some have made their way to the more peaceful shores of Europe. One of these European destinations is Austria.

Ministry Obstacles

Whether the Afghans are Sunni Muslim (Pashtuns and Tajiks) or Shia (Hazaras) they cannot imagine leaving Islam for any other "religion." Islam is central to their identity.

Outreach Ideas

German-speaking believers can help the Afghans learn their language. They can also teach job skills that will help them adapt to Austria's modern economy.

Prayer Focus

There are no known Afghan believers in Austria. Pray for Western believers filled with the fruit of the Holy Spirit to go to the Afghans and other Muslim communities in Austria. Pray for the Holy Spirit to move in Afghan
