



Manasir in Sudan

The Manasir people are one of many Afro-Arab tribes of Northern Sudan who pursue small scale agriculture in the immediate vicinity of the Nile. Research suggests that the Manasir community is a combination of indigenous, mostly Nubian groups, descendants of emigrating Arabs, and tribal minorities.

Ministry Obstacles

Much of Sudan can be difficult for ministry, especially for outsiders. Many parts are harsh and difficult with limited job and travel options. It is not a safe country.

Outreach Ideas

Caring for the material and physical needs of the Manasir is essential if anyone wishes to do outreach towards them. There must be genuine concern for their needs and a wish to help them with medical, educational, and material needs.
