Kapu in India



In Telugu, the word Kapu means protector. Kapu subcastes have evolved based on occupation. Those who engaged in trade were referred to as Balija. Today many Kapus have diversified into industry, arts and academia. However, many Kapu are still farmers. Modern day Kapus have banded together to fight for their political rights in the caste system. They have also organized agricultural unions to protect their way of life.

Ministry Obstacles

Fear that Christianity aims to turn individuals from their families, communities and traditions is one means Satan uses to hinder Kapu families and communities from considering what Jesus can do for their communities.

Outreach Ideas

Believers among the Kapu can be trained to engage their communities in discovering and experiencing God's blessing through sharing and discussing Bible stories.

Pray for all Kapu believers to be bold and loving in discussing God's word
