



Katso in China

The Katso of China proudly retain their ethnic identity as Mongols. In the early 1980s, Katso village elders sent a delegation to Inner Mongolia to learn about Mongolian culture, and they immediately adopted customs similar to Mongols. Wrestling became their favorite sport when they saw how popular it was with other Mongols.

Ministry Obstacles

Efforts to take the gospel to them have been met with stubborn resistance and opposition from village leaders and local police who are eager to preserve the Mongolian traditions.

Outreach Ideas

The religion of the Katso is a mixture of Buddhism and Daoism. Posters of fierce Daoist deities hang on the doors and gates of their homes to ward off evil spirits. Christian believers can show them the power of Christ to stand against demons.

Prayer Focus

There is no Christian church among the Katso, so pray for a spiritual breakthrough. Pray that Christian Mongolians from (outer) Mongolia evangelize them and show that
