The Radhi Brahmins are mainly in India's eastern state of West Bengal and Kulna, a province of Bangladesh that we will feature for prayer this week. Brahmins are the key community that has traditionally upheld Hinduism. Though Brahmins have their origins as priests and gurus, most Radhis have other occupations in today's world. Some benefit from owning farmland while others are businessmen.

Ministry Obstacles

Since they have the highest status of any Hindu community, Brahmins believe that they have everything to lose by converting to another religious system, and most believe that switching to a "different God" will result in an inferior reincarnation after they die. High caste communities like the Brahmins often have pride in their status, and pride is an enemy of faith.

Outreach Ideas

To reach them for Christ, someone will have to enter their world and learn how to communicate in the Brahmin way. This will involve much listening and learning before speaking.
