The Jhalawan Brahui are a tribal people and are one of the country's Baloch tribes. They live mainly in Baloch Province. Little is known about their lives.

Ministry Obstacles

One significant obstacle to ministry is that the Jhalawan have a low literacy rate, so gospel materials must be presented in other forms. This tribal group is also completely Muslim, so they are not open to the only way to salvation, the blood of Jesus Christ.

Outreach ideas

Believers can enrich Jhalawan lives by helping them with education, healthcare and improved infrastructure. Those who bring these advances can also advance the gospel when their loving care matches their loving words. Audio scriptures and teachings will be effective tools for this illiterate culture.

Pray for the Christ followers in Pakistan to be equipped and inspired to bring the good news to the Jhalawan. Pray that God's message of love will pierce their hearts
