



# Uuld in Mongolia

**U**uld people still live the traditional, pastoral lifestyle. They raise horses, cattle, camels, goats, sheep and yak. They move four or five times a year, seeking water and grass for their animals.

## Obstacles

Illiteracy is a major problem for the nomadic Uuld people. Their lifestyle is not conducive to the education of their children. Children who do go to school often have to quit school early to help with their family business of caring for animals. These factors keep them from using any printed gospel material.

## Outreach Ideas

The complete Bible and the JESUS Film are available in Halh Mongolian, the primary language of the Uuld. They need to hear the life-changing message of Jesus Christ who alone can free them from the fear of evil spirits and forgive their sins. Medical workers, teachers and trainers of new job skills are needed as the old nomadic lifestyle is disappearing.

## Prayer Focus

Radio broadcasts might be useful. Pray that the Church would take
