ow do you reach a people if they feel threatened by religious change? That is the situation for the Pipipa people of Brazil. They speak Portuguese, but their identity is deeply rooted in their ethnic religion. Leaving their traditional religion is viewed by their community as one more part of their culture robbed from them.

Ministry Obstacles

There are well-meaning efforts by the Brazilian government to protect indigenous people from missionaries, loggers and other outsiders who can potentially introduce diseases for which native peoples have no immunity.

Outreach Ideas

Some Pipipa live outside their homeland, and they can potentially be reached by Brazil's spiritually healthy Church. New believers among them could return to their homeland and help build a movement to Christ among this unreached people group.

Prayer Focus

Pray for Christ to reveal himself to
