



Kulung in Nepal

Some Kulung were in the British military in the two World Wars, and they are noted for their military abilities. The Kulung of eastern Nepal have their own language and culture. They lack food due to poor land growing conditions. They lack electricity, clean drinking water and health services.

Ministry Obstacles

Some of them are Hindus, some Buddhists and others follow folk religion. The Kulung people are difficult to reach due to a lack of suitable roads and this could be an obstacle to gospel outreach.

Outreach Ideas

Although the abundance of land has made cultivation of new acreage possible, productivity is greatly limited by insufficient technology. Disciples who are knowledgeable in farming and related technology might fill a need in this area. The New Testament exists in Kulung, as well as audio materials.
