he Mazhabi live in India's northern Punjab state and call themselves Rai Sikh. They speak Punjabi and read and write in Gurmukhi. Sikhism is their religion. They are non-vegetarian who also eat wheat, maize, and rice as cereals. The Mazhabi are endogamous, meaning they prefer to marry within their group. Many of the Mazhabi work in agriculture and laboring and some in government service. Only boys receive can education. The Mazhabi use modern medicine.

Most Sikh Mazhabi people live in India's northern states where there are very few believers.
