

Razihi in Yemen



The Razihi people dwell in Yemen's Houthi-controlled northwestern desert. The Razihi, a small people group, speak a unique language. Even Yemen's Arabic speakers cannot understand Razihi, nor can the Razihi understand Arabic. Not only do they struggle to grow meager crops and to herd livestock, they also live near the Saudi border where war has been a daily occurrence for nearly a decade. Some Razihi work in the oil industry.

Obstacles

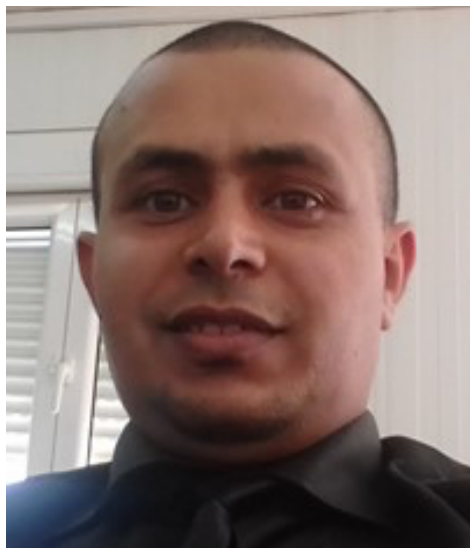
Communication, geographic access and a misperception of Christ challenge ministry efforts. The level of poverty makes it unlikely that the internet could be a tool. Christians coming to meet their physical needs are sometimes killed in the name of Allah simply for believing in Christ.

Outreach Ideas
