The Allu live in eight villages in the Allu District of Polewali Mandar Regency, West Sulawesi Province. Their mother tongue is Mandar. The Allu are farmers and traders. They mainly raise water buffalo, goats, cattle and chicken. Because their villages are far from major highways and larger cities, their economy is suffering.

Ministry Obstacles

The Allu are Muslim. Their traditional religion also consists of spiritism, as seen in their high regard for their ancestors' graves. Both of these are spiritual barriers to the gospel.

Outreach Ideas

There are portions of the Bible that have been translated into their heart language. The distribution of Bible portions can be part of God's plan to reach the Allu people.

Prayer Focus

There is no church to pray for. Pray for Christian believers throughout Sulawesi to take Christ to the Allu community. Pray that the rest of the Bible would be translated into Mandar. Pray that Christian workers would rise up to share the gospel with the Allu. Pray that the Allu would experi
