Living on the island of Java in Indonesia, most Banten people work as merchants or farmers. They grow rice and other crops such as coffee, cloves, jenkol beans, bananas, and durian. Cooperative work is a big part of their daily lives, as is their religion. The Banten people are officially Muslim, but many participate in a variety of mystical arts. The Banten speak a dialect of the Sunda language.

Ministry Obstacles

Religion is a large part of the Banten's lives. In fact, they are so known for some of their religious practices that people from surrounding areas travel, hoping to be benefitted by their rituals. It is a staple in their community.

Outreach Ideas

Tourism is active there. Because of this, there are many ways to spread the word in the community. Outreach could also come from nearby Javanese believers.
