ach Turkmen tribe has its own individual history of when they migrated to the Middle East. Some Turkmen tribes arrived at the time of Genghis Khan in the 1200s. Others arrived later during the Ottoman Empire. There are Turkmen populations located throughout the Middle East, including Lebanon. Some Turkmen self-identify as Turks whereas others identify as Turkmen. Those in Lebanon usually speak Turkmen at home as their heart language.

Obstacles

The Turkmen are often very uneasy being around people who are not from their tribe. They are not very receptive to ideas and beliefs that conflict with Sunni Islam.

Outreach Ideas

A complete Bible translation is available in Turkish. Use of Scripture is important for greater outreach and a major spiritual breakthrough.

Prayer Focus

There is one steadily growing Turkmen church. Pray that it is able to prosper and that the Turkmen people benefit from its presence in
