

Jola in Bangladesh



Jola people live among the large Bengali speaking peoples. They live in Bangladesh, especially the states of Rajshahi and Dhaka. Smaller numbers live in other parts of the country.

Ministry Obstacles

Jola people are almost entirely Sunni Muslim, and as far as we know, there are no Christ followers among them. Like most Muslims in South Asia, the Jola people put their faith in their obedience to the teachings of the Koran for their eternal salvation, but they look to local spirits for their daily needs. They do not understand that they need a savior who is free from sin.

Outreach Ideas

The complete Bible, as well as audio and visual resources (including the JESUS Film), exist in the Bengali language of the Jola people, yet they remain unreached. These resources can be instruments of God's Holy Spirit to show Jola people the way of eternal life.

Prayer Focus

Pray for a vibrant Jola-based Church to begin in Bangladesh soon. Pray for the Lord to thrust out workers to
