

Jadun Pashtun in Pakistan



The Pashtun of Afghanistan and Pakistan are politically divided, but united by the Pashtunwali code of honor and their descent from Father Abraham. They are nearly all Muslim. They seek to maintain coherence despite their many clan, tribe and political factions. One of their clans is the Jadun.

Ministry Obstacles:

Cultural divisions, pride and suspicion of outsiders limit outreach as does the Islamic belief that the Bible is “corrupt” and that Jesus is only a prophet, not the only way to salvation and reconciliation with God.

Outreach Ideas:

There are people in the Pashtun diaspora who have ties to the Jadun Pashtun in Pakistan. Christ's ambassadors can capitalize on their belief that they are descended from Abraham, so that it may become a “bridge of God.” They can focus on the realization that the blessing of Abraham is fulfilled in Christ. This can be done through literature, radio, the JESUS Film and television.

Pray for the Church:

There are no Pashtun churches; but there are Pakistani churches to
